OVERVIEW

ew stories weave fantasy and surrealism as effortlessly as *Alice in Wonderland*. It is fitting, then, that Salvador Dalí, the master of the surreal, transformed Lewis Carroll's tale into one of his most celebrated illustrated series. This original 1968 painting, *Le Terrain de croquet de la reine (The Queen's Croquet Ground)*, is a striking depiction of the story's famed Queen of Hearts.

Dali's interpretation of Carroll's *Alice in Wonderland* exemplifies the perfect alliance between two visionary creators. In this scene of Alice's croquet match, Dali's distinctive motifs—two large flamingo mallets and the executioner in the background transport viewers into the depths of the subconscious. The Queen of Hearts, possibly representing the viewer, dominates the composition. Her commanding figure embodying the unrestrained passion that both shocked the Victorian sensibilities of Carroll's audience and aligned perfectly with Dalí's exploration of dream logic.

This gouache, watercolor and ink painting laid the foundation for one of Dalí's most significant published works. In 1969, Maecenas Press-Random House in New York released a limited edition of *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* featuring Dalí's artwork (a set of 12 lithographs, one for every chapter). These books are now held in prestigious rare book collections around the world, with exhibitions dedicated to the series at institutions including the Panhandle-Plains Museum of Art, the University of South Florida, and the Philbrook Museum of Art in Oklahoma. Each of these first-edition books is rare and highly sought after, but the original gouache paintings such as this are the ultimate collector's item.

Born in Catalonia in 1904, Dalí was formally educated in the fine arts in Madrid, particularly falling under the influence of the Impressionists and the Renaissance masters. At a young age, he became associated with the Madrid avant-garde group Ultra, though he eventually became more acquainted with other major movements such as Cubism, Dada and Futurism.

Today, he is remembered as one of the most legendary and significant contributors to Surrealism. His *Persistence of Memory*, with its melting clocks, is arguably the most recognizable painting of the movement. Two museums—one in St. Petersburg, Florida and another in Catalonia—are entirely devoted to his oeuvre. Other important works by the artist can be found in the Museum of Modern Art in New York, the Art Institute of Chicago, the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the Philadelphia Museum of Art and the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C., among many others.




