


Caricature d'un homme

Claude Monet is undoubtedly one of the most important artists of all time. Before he was the famed member of the Impressionist revolution in Paris, Monet was an extraordinary chronicler of his Normandy neighbors. Please see photos of one of his magnificent, exceptionally rare caricatures from 1857—a masterwork that offers a seldom-seen glimpse into the clever mind of the great artist.

In this work, Monet reveals the same sharp eye and expert draftsmanship that would later define his monumental career. His linework is confident and fluid, bringing the bespectacled gentleman to life with both naturalism and good-natured humor. With his comically large top hat and a mustache that defies gravity, Monet's subject perfectly embodies the young artist's talent for capturing the essence of the world around him.

Monet created his first caricatures at a young age, while studying drawing under Jacques-François Ochard. Soon, he was selling these witty depictions of his professors and the local townspeople for 20 francs per portrait. This success led him to an exhibition of around 100 of these drawings at Gravier's, the framer's shop in Le Havre. Monet described watching passersby gather at the window to smile and laugh, remarking, "I was just bursting with pride."

Very few of Monet's iconic caricatures survive today, and the overwhelming majority are in major museums, including the Art Institute of Chicago, the Musée d'Orsay and the Clark Art Institute. Our drawing also has the distinction of bearing the desirable signature "O. Monet," a rare occurrence as the artist then went by his formal name Oscar-Claude Monet. This extraordinary drawing is a rare treasure in this legendary artist's oeuvre.






Claude Monet | *Caricature of Auguste Vacquerie*
